#### **Entry Specifications**

All entries must be typewritten on standard white paper, one poem per page. No limit on number of entries.

Submit only original, unpublished poetry which has not been a previous contest winner.

Poems may be in any style. Twenty-eight (28) line limit. No insulting or offensive language.

Submit two copies of each poem, with name and other identifying information of the entrant on the back of each; include payment of a 100 entry fee for each poem submitted. Make check or MO payable to **PSJ**.

### **Awards and Recognition**

First Prize will be \$25, Second Prize will be \$15, and Third Prize will be \$10. Honorable Mentions may be awarded at the discretion of the judges. Poets of the San Joaquin may choose to print the prize-winning poems in the annual PSJ Anthology. Poets retain all other rights to their own work. Winners will be notified by October 31, 2006.
